<u>Program</u>

Those who study the role of regions in fostering economic growth and an innovative economy have discovered the importance of the so-called ,triple-helix approach'. This is the approach where governments, knowledge institutes and entrepreneurs closely work together in developing smart specialization strategies. These strategies go beyond the simplicity of dual state-market schemes, in which governments were often seen as a hindrance to economic success. Successful strategies that foster economic growth and innovation seem to blossom especially at a regional level, the level that seems to be especially successful in enabling effective co-operation, fueled by shared identities, practical proximities and mutual trust.

During the XXIIIrd European Days, we shall meet in the provinces of Noord-Brabant and Limburg, located in the South of The Netherlands. They work closely together in the ,Brainport 2020' area, an area in which important industries have committed themselves to many urgent societal endeavors, such as a sustainable agri- and food sector, smart mobility, renewable energy and healthy ageing. We will meet in 's-Hertogenbosch, Eindhoven and Maastricht, to see how the STR is involved in fostering economic co-operation and innovation. We convene in the year that commemorates the 25th anniversary of the Treaty of Maastricht and in which The Netherlands will hold the EU-presidency. 


