



Where are Ukrainians fleeing to?

At least 520,000 people have fled Ukraine into Poland and other neighbouring countries in the wake of Russia's invasion, UNHCR says. All men aged between 18 and 60 have been banned from leaving the country to take up arms.









Ukrainian refugees in Hungary since the beginning of the war


- more than 2 million refugees have arrived
- more than 195,000 of them applied for a temporary residence permit
- more than 30,000 received refugee status




















The role of the capital and county government offices in providing humanitarian aid for Ukrainian citizens fleeing from the war

- conclusion of agreements with the accommodation providers and employers, and administration of their subsidy requests;
- administration of the subsidy requests of the local authorities providing shelter for the refugees;
- forwarding the application for the recognition of a person with asylum status submitted in the Government Windows (integrated customer service offices).
